Lightweight vs. Standard or Heavy-weight webbing

First- A quick word about lightweight nylon webbing, vs. standard weight!





There's a BIG difference between the look and usage of lightweight nylon webbing vs. the regular (or heavyweight) webbing you'll generally find online or in shops. As you can see in these photos, the lightweight webbing (at left) is noticeably thinner and more flexible. It's also WAY easier to use and to sew thru.

But does this mean you can't use the standard weight webbing? No, it technically does not and as you can see in these examples, I successfully used it for this particular sample but I must tell you it was <u>very</u> tough at times and even though I have a heavy-duty sewing machine, it was touch n' go at times as to whether it would actually sew thru these multiple layers. My advice? Use the lightweight webbing if possible.
