Steps 53a-55—Attaching Side Walls to Bag Back




Step 53a

Here's two different shots of aligning the top <u>SEAM*</u> of Zip Panel with single notch at top curve of Bag Back.

*Please note— you want to align the top SEAM... not necessarily the edge of the bias tape.








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Steps 53a-55—Attaching Side Walls to Bag Back (cont.)





It may not seem so, but it really is a LOT easier to stitch the SideWall to the Bag Back by doing so with the "Tech-Pocket-side" face down on the machine bed... as seen at left.



And here's two shots of the bias taping. :)

And here's an important tip.

I generally use a dark thread (for top and bottom) to do this stitching.

#1- even with the dark thread, it just wont show on the inside because it will be buried deep within the interior seam, and...

#2- I've found that if I u se a light colored thread to math the interior, that sometimes I see little snippets of the stitching on the outside dark exterior, even though I stitched the seam accurately!
