



Step 24-26b — Creating CC Slots

24) After folding up your CC Slot unit in steps 20-24, it should look like the one at right.

Each fold line should be exactly **3/87** below the previous fold line.

Loosely baste \sim 1" from each side edges to secure your folds.





25) Place a Flange(#5) along BOTH side edges of BOTH CC Slots aligning raw edges & the single & double notches on either end of CC Slots. (at left) (They should <u>roughly</u> align, but don't panic if they are off a bit.)

Stitch 1/4" from each edge on both sides. (There's a lot of layers here, so stitch & do get a full 1/4" seam.)

Press Flanges away from unit then topstitch close to seam.



In order to secure your cards in these slots firmly... topstitch an additional line EXACTLY 1/4" from <u>ONE</u> CC side edge (it doesn't matter which side).



Load cards in BOTH units. They should be secure but not too hard to get in & out. If need be you can add another line of stitching on the opposite side of your unit. Set aside ONE CC Slots unit for step 34
