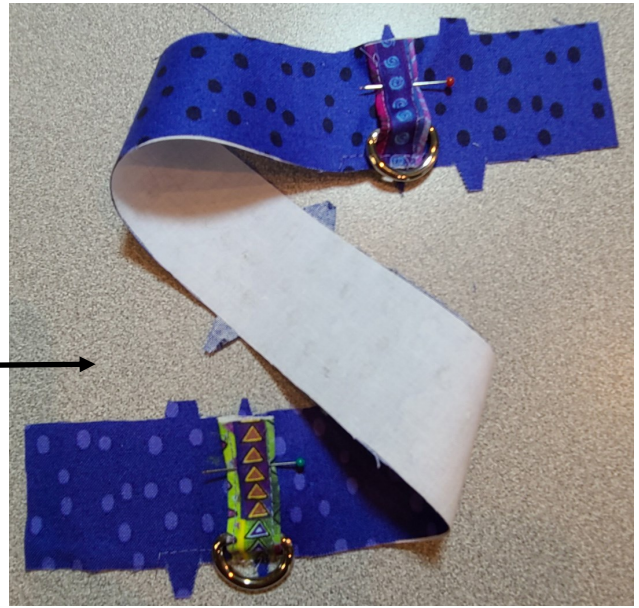


# the Elsie K Baglet

## Step 36-38b – Stitching Ring Tab to Panel 1

36) Thread a 5/8" wide D-ring onto Ring Tab & place it sideways across RS of Panel 1 in contrast (#16) centering Ring Tab ends over side single-notches on opposite ends of Panel 1. Baste close to both Ring Tab ends to secure placement.

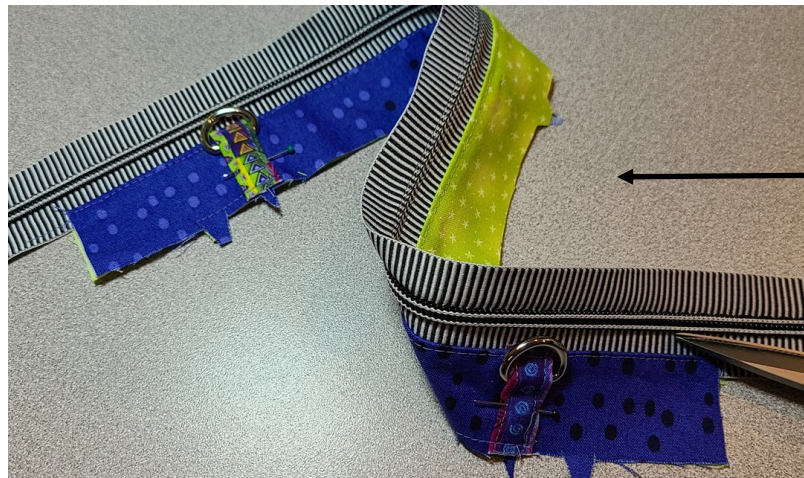
(Please note that the Ring Tab does NOT lay flat across the Panel. There's a planned amount of slack purposely built in.)



37) Mark center of a 22" zipper on WS of upper & lower edge. Move BOTH zipper pulls to one end of zipper then place it RSU on flat surface. Now place Panel 1 in contrast RST with zipper centering single notch over zipper mark on upper edge of zipper. Stitch in place a scant 1/4" from edges.

(Notice that the D-ring is pinned away from the stitching area.)

38a) Place Panel 1 in lining **RSD on WS** of zipper sandwiching zipper in between layers & aligning all edges & notches. Stitch a full 1/4" from edges.



38a cont.) Press BOTH Panels UP & AWAY from zipper then topstitch close to finished seam.

38b) With Panel 1 LSD, push D-ring on each Ring Tab as close as possible to zipper edge. Stitch in place close to underlying D-ring edge thru ALL layers of fabric (this stitching **will be** visible on panel lining). Reinforce stitching. This is your Wide Panel unit.
