

Steps 54-56 — Attaching Bag Back to Wide Panel unit



If for some reason you didn't baste your pen slots DOWN in step 6. You can always pin them down now. (Believe me, it'll help as you proceed.)



54) Flip Bag Front "Wallet-side" UP & place raw edges EST w/Bag Back aligning all edges & notches & totally enclosing Bag Front INSIDE Bag Back. Clip remaining free Wide Panel edges to stay-stitching at the four corners to aid in easing them in place. Stitch a full 1/4" from edges with Mesh Pocket side of Bag Back face DOWN on machine bed. Restitch seam for security.



55) In this photo, we're stitching the Bag Back (mesh pocket side DOWN) to the Wide Panel unit.



56) Flip bias tape up & over raw edge to "Wide Panel-side" of Bag. Pin bias tape in place enveloping raw edges within, then machine stitch in place a scant 1/4" from edges thru ALL layers using a zipperfoot with Mesh Pocket side of Bag Back face DOWN on machine bed.
