

## the Double Take

Steps 43-44: Finishing Touches

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So the "finishing touches" for the **Double Take** really amount to bias-taping the raw edges of the Bag Front. I've included these pictures to give you some idea of how I go about it.

It's a little hard to see with this busy print but this arrow is directing you to the diagonal edge that starts the process for me.

And here's the bias tape all pinned in place, and yes... I really DO use that many pins!







Again, this process tends to be a bit awkward simply because of having to hold the bulk of that bag out of your sewing area. As you can see here, I literally bend the layers back to clear my sewing path.

(it's necessary most in the top edges of the Bag Front).

Now all you'll need to do is flip the bias tape over the raw edges and stitch in place... this time a scant 1/4" from the edges but still with your Bag Front face down on your machine bed!



Here's two other shot of how the bias tape look in the bag corners. I try to keep those pressed edges pinned down so they don't get involved in this stitching.
