

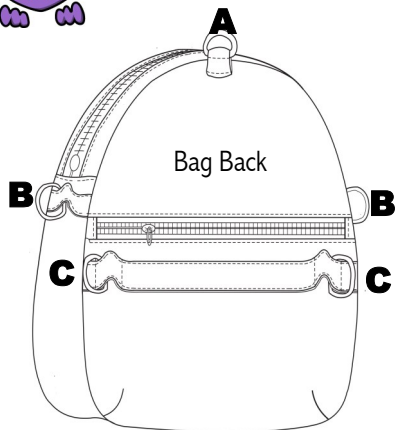

Step 52- Configuring your Bag as a Backpack—Page 1

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Please refer to this diagram as we work thru these pictures to show you how to convert your High Seas Convertible into a convenient backpack!



First, using the slide buckle, on your strap, extend your strap to it FULL length



Pass the opposite snaphook THRU the "A" D-ring,





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And here's a couple of good shots-

Above— the High Seas Convertible configured
to be worn as a back[ack

At left— How it when being worn in this configuration

As an alternative— you can also achieve this look by creating TWO shorter straps (~50" long each) Each strap will then be hooked in one of the two "C" D-ring and also the top "A" D-ring. Be advised that choosing this method will ALSO require the need for another complete set of strap hardware (which included two 1" wide swivel snaphooks, and one 1" wide slide buckle).
