

Wrapsody step 35-37– Stitching Walls in place



Step 41– Here's our RingHolder centered over the side edge of our Center Pocket. It's important to notice how we've pinned it in place... vertically with the point UP.

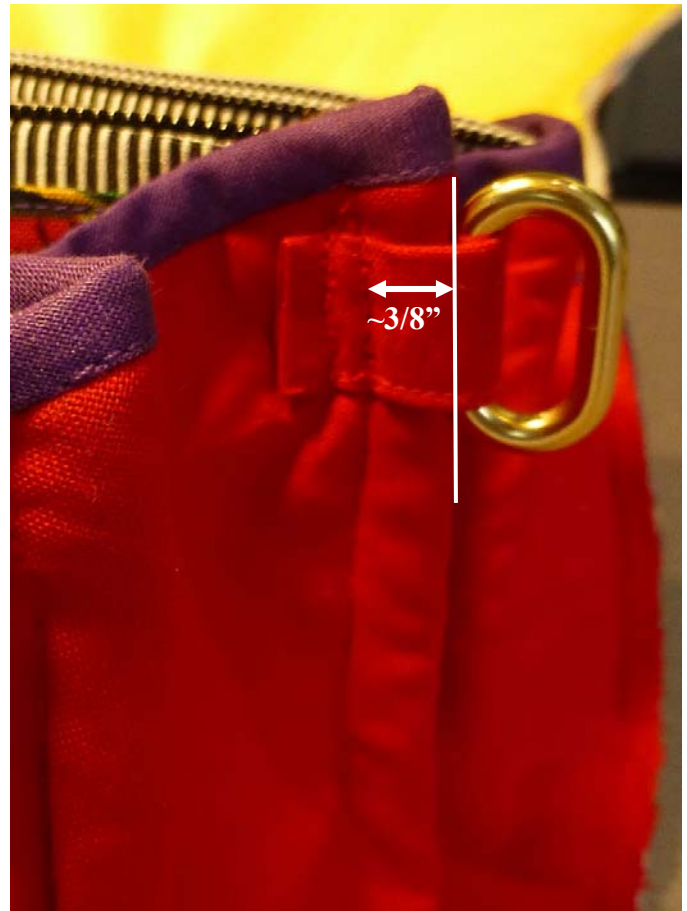
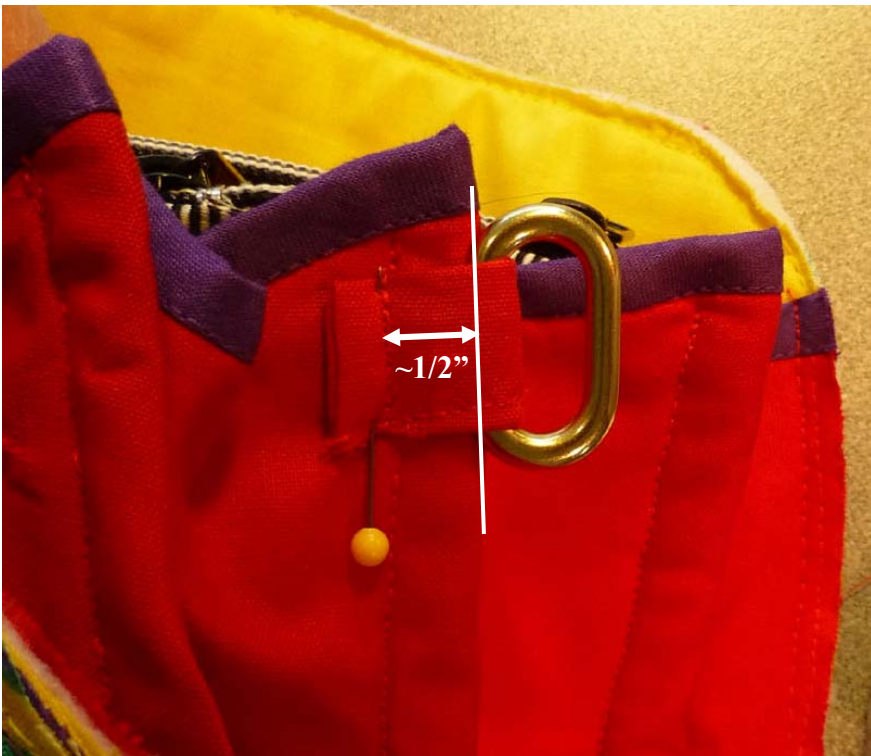
What you can't see is that it's ALSO pinned in place on the underside of the Center Pocket in the SAME exact way.

Pull the Ring Holder edges as tight as possible against the Pocket edge. You don't want a saggy baggy Ring Holder.

Step 42– Start stitching your Ring Holder in place by placing your needle near the top Ring Holder edge. Stitch a scant 1/2" from the metal ring edge (see vertical white line in picture at left).

Reinforce stitching at both ends and if you'll notice in the picture, we didn't have to remove this pin or the one underneath while we were stitching. Due to the way we had placed our pins in step 41, they didn't get in our way. :)



Step 43– Now you can take your pins out if you want to and restitch the area again, only this time you want to stitch a vertical line ~3/8" from the edge of the metal ring.
