## Bangle Buddie- Attaching Thin Panel to unit to Bag Front - Steps 18-20



18) Align <u>ZIPPER</u> side of Thin Panel unit EST with Bag exterior by <u>FIRST matching triple</u> <u>notches</u> along Base, then aligning all other edges & notches. (Please notice that we used LOTS of pins in this process.) Here's another view (below).





Using a zipper foot (<u>in this step & thru step 21</u>), stitch a full 1/4" from edges with LS of Bag Front facing DOWN on machine bed.

(You may have to stop stitching & move zipper heads out of your way during this procedure.)



19) Begin pinning bias tape in place RST along the long Base edges on <u>LS of Bag Front</u> aligning raw edges. Continue pinning around entire circumference of Bag Front then overlap bias tape tail ~3/4" onto the diagonally folded end.





Flip entire unit <u>LS DOWN on machine bed</u> then stitch a <u>scant 1/4</u>" from edges.

20) Now all that's left is to flip the bias tape over raw seam edges of Bag Front & pin them in place on Panel (in lining) side of seam.

Stitch close to pressed edges (once again with Bag Front LS DOWN on machine bed).
