

*Baggalista- Step 15-16.
Applying Bias Tape to the Flap- page 1*



After you press a 1/4" fold (WST) into your bias tape, align the NON-pressed edge to all but the top edge of your Flap. LOTS of pins keeps it extra stable. Stitch it in place a full 1/4" from the raw edges.



Don't forget to reinforce that stitching as you go across both ends of the zipper.

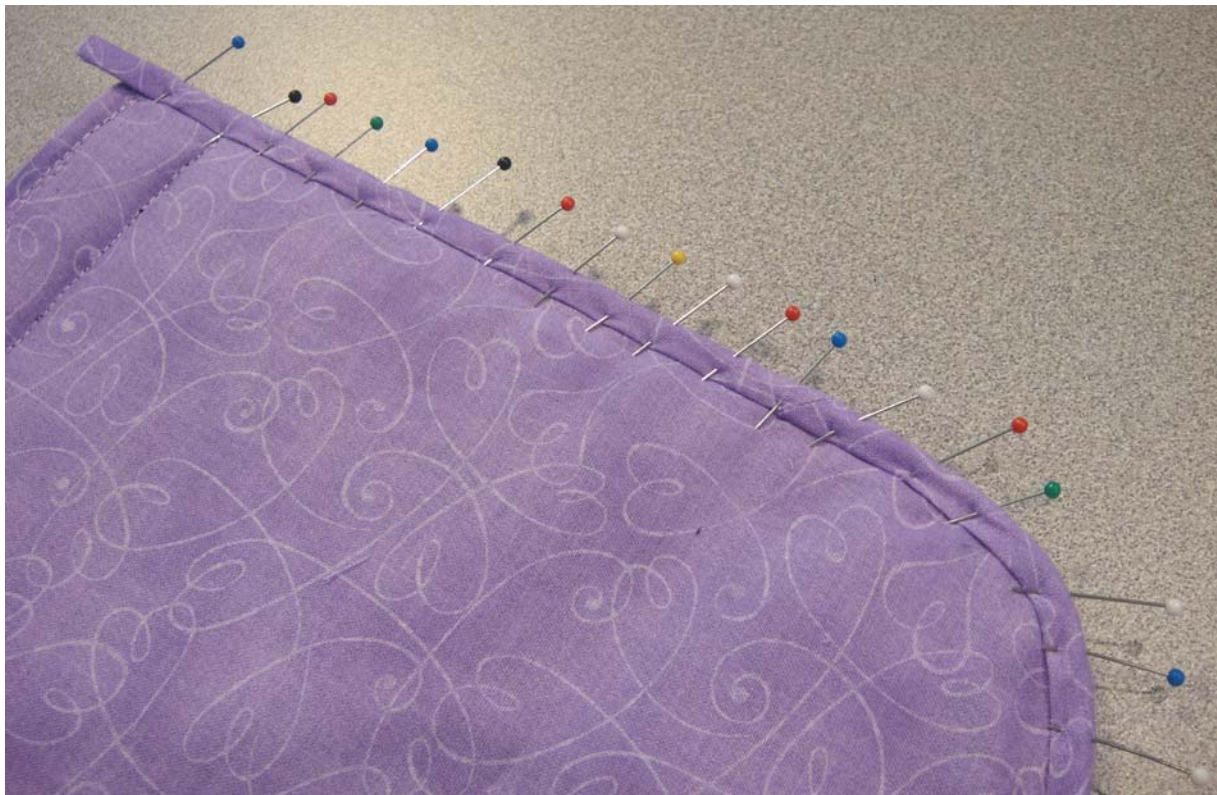


Carefully trim seam to ~1/8". Slow & steady does it here.
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Applying Bias Tape to the Flap- page 3



Now it's easy to just flip your bias tape over to the lining side of your Flap. Pin it in place. Lots of pins folks,,,it really helps to pin it in place with LOTS of pins.



Applying Bias Tape to the Flap- page 4



I like to stitch it in place "in the ditch". (In other words, as much as possible, right where the Flap fabric meets the bias tape fabric. The stitching will show less here.

Please note: if you pin it in place as I have shown you, you can stitch on the right side of the Flap, and still be able to pull your pins out as you reach them.



Here's how it looks on the underside. PERFECT!
