

## Baggalista- Step 47-49 Zipper Panels- Page 1




As you can see, the triple-notched edge of your Zipper Panels are curved and your zipper? Well it's as straight as an arrow. So we can either struggle with this, OR We can cut small clips into the triple-notched edge (after stay-stitching it first of course!) to facilitate this process. It's WAY better to make many small clips, close to, but not over the stay-stitching. As a




When you get your Zipper Panel pinned in place, it's going to make your zipper 'bow-up' like this.

Carefully stitch it in place. I try to remove each pic as I come to it, or it can effect how straight your stitching is. Yeah, I know this slows the process down, but just think how beautiful it's going to look when you're done!

## Zipper Panels- Page 1



Install your second Zipper Panel in the same way. Once you match up the raw ends of both Panels, it's sometime easier to open the zipper and align this 2nd Panel to just one edge of the zipper.



And here's the way it looks when you're done. I know it looks a little weird now, but its doing just what we need it to when it's in our bag opening. :)
