Installing Zip Panels in Bag



Step 35-Pin your Zip panel to the Bag Lining (making sure you do with "lining sides together"). That's the easy part.

The important part is to STOP pinning at black circle on each Zip Panel side edge. These marks should ALSO be visible on the Bag Lining AND the Side Walls (as was done in Prelim step A). Your last pin on each Zip Panel should be **right on this black circle**.

There should be 4 black circle, (two on each Zip Panel). Once they are pinned in place you can push the Zip Panel ends under and **exterior side DOWN** on the Bag Lining (as depicted in this photo at right).

As you can see, a 22" purse zipper is just barely long enough to reach around the perimeter of this bag.

(And just in case you're thinking that these Zip Panels look shorter than yours, you're RIGHT! I deliberately made the Zip Panels in your package LONGER in order to make this step a little easier for you! :)





When steps 35-37 are accomplished correctly, your Bag will "bow up" slightly as seen in the photo at left.

This doesn't present a problem at all, especially since we want the Bag to "bow up" way more than this to close, right?
