Zip Pouch (part 3)- steps 22-23



OK- once again, all 3 of these pictures are take at different angles of the step to give you the perspective you might need:

I've prepressed that 1/4' hem in the bottom of the last Zip Pouch in lining which happens to be the one that has mag-snaps in it.

FYI- when these pictures were taken, I was installing the mag-snaps in a different spot in the instructions, so... If you're wondering why you don't see the stitching for them in these pictures, that would be why.)

So... With the right side and a portion of the top pinned in place, I'll stop at this point and secure this area with stitching.





Zip Pouch (part 3)steps 22-23

With the right side stitched, now I can move the zipper heads and pin the left side together, leaving the bottom prepressed edge unstitched for turning.

At right and below:

Our Zip Pouch is now completely pinned and ready for stitching. Once this is accomplished we'll flip the lining over the zipper so that the ENTIRE Zip pouch with be lining-side OUT now.
