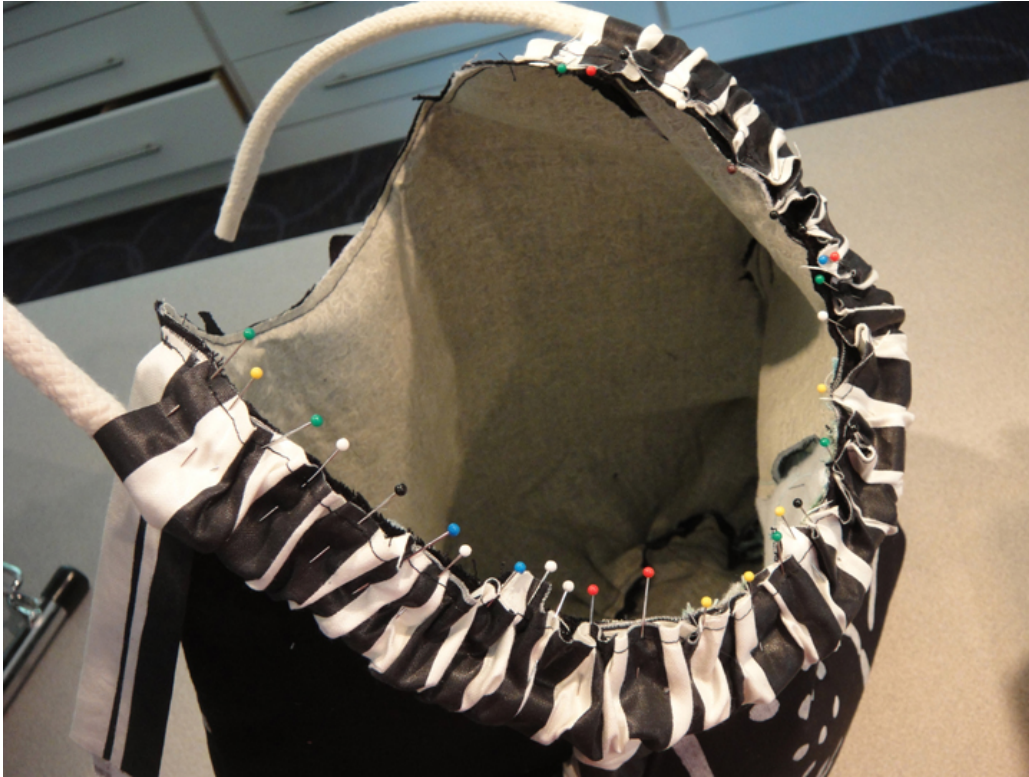


## Applying the Rim Edging



Step 21a— Here's my bag with the 1st of the 2 Rim Edgings applied. (I actually find it to be easier to pin and stitch one Rim Edging in place first, and then to go back and pin and stitch the 2nd in place. Once both are in place, pull on both piping ends to gather the edging. Ease ALL the edges in place. It's easy when you use LOTS of pins!



Step 21b— The Rim Edging ends should meet in the center of the underlying Loop.

Step 22— Once they're both stitched in place, you'll want to get rid of some of that excess piping. Just remember to tape the area first and cut the piping THRU the tape. :)
