Stitching Loops in place



Step 46a— Here's the pressed edge of the Loop, pulled up & over Rim Edging to the lining side of the DittyRoo. The pressed edge is aligned 3/8" below the Rim Edging.



Step 46b— The directions call for stitching the Loop in place from the inside, 1/4" above the Loop's pressed edges, & that works just fine, but, I prefer to stitch them in place from the exterior, by stitching over the Step 44 topstitching from side edge to side edge of Loop. Reinforce the stitching of course, & check to make sure the entire pressed edge of each Loop got caught in the stitching underneath.

Step 47 +48- Here's an extreme closeup up the Loop stitching that conceals the piping & Rim Edging junctions. I prefer doing this stitching from the outside, since this area is very visible, but it can easily be accomplishing from the inside, if you prefer doing it that way. Using a zipperfoot to stitch under the metal ring will help get as close as possible to the ring, and best stabilize the area.
