Step 50 – Inserting Your Pouch Linings

50– It can be a real effort to get your Pouch Linings pulled over your Bag Pouches, especially for the Back Pouch (*due to all the layering out there along with the Flap*).

Start by matching the side areas, snchoring them in place with pins. Then work toward the center double-notched area of Bag.



Remember to keep the bottom zipper area open and unpinned or stitched. I generally push that zipper end down in between the layers (*see the bottom photo*). It seems to get in the way less there, but you still have to be careful not to involved ANY of the zipper bottom area in this stitching.

Once you're happy with the pinning you can begin stitching 1/4" from edges by once again starting at a 3/4" pin marker at a zipper bottom area.

DO NOT stitch across the zipper bottom area. This area **MUST** stay open and unstitched for now.
