## Steps 28-30: Completing 1st Zipper Pouch



Now its time to finish off this 1st Zipper Pouch and this is definitely another 2-step procedure.

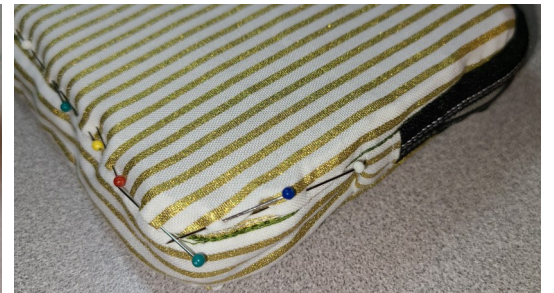
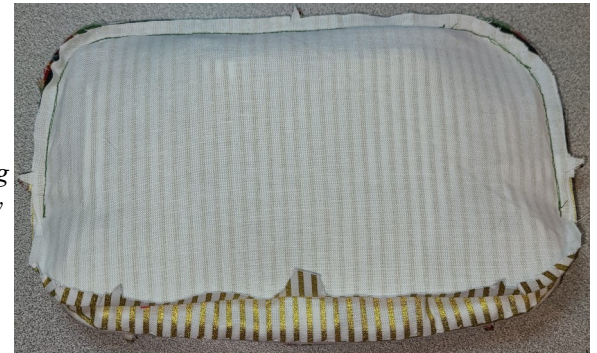
As you can see at left, start by placing another Pouch in lining RSD on WS of zipper aligning your zipper mark with the top single notch. As you can in both shots, I usually pin about 2/3 of the lining in place for now then stitch a FULL 1/4" from edges this time.



Once accomplished you can now go back to pin and stitch the remaining area of the Pouch lining in place.

*(I won't lie, it takes a bit of coaxing to get the Pouch lining in place this way, but its really not that hard.)*

When you're finished it should like the photo at right.



Flip the lining UP & OVER the zipper now & pin in place to conceal raw edges of Wall lining. *(I purposely used green thread this time so you can see that I make no effort to conceal the stitching here...only the raw edges of the Wall.)*



*(at left)* Here's how your 1st Zipper Pouch looks after stitching the lower edge in place.

*(at right)* Now it's time to turn the whole Pouch RSO which reveals the completed Zipper Pouch AND the Expander in all of its glory! :D

Set it aside for step 41a.
