## Steps 25-29

### Applying Zipper to Bag Top

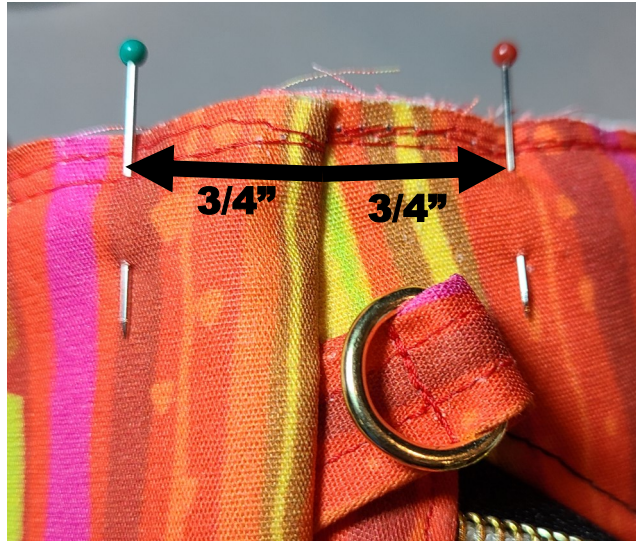

25) Place a marker pin exactly 3/4" away from the side seams on Front & Back Bag top edges (*this means FOUR pin placements*).

26) Open zipper completely & place zipper RST with Pouch Back. The **top zipper stop** should be even with the marker pin that's 3/4" away from the **RIGHT** side seam of your **Pouch Back**.



27a) Continue pinning zipper in place even with Pouch edges. Stop pinning at the pin that 3/4" from the opposite side seam.

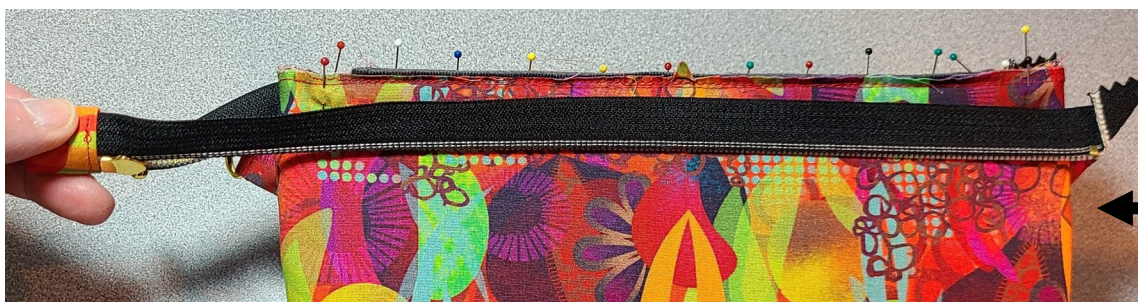


27b) Here's how it should look now.



***It's of utmost importance... that you apply your zipper w/the correct RS & WS relationship to your Bag Top.***

**1st**— Bring free zipper edge over to Bag Back (w/zipper WSD on Bag ext & w/zipper teeth facing UP).



**NEXT**— Flip zipper edge UP so that its RST with bag exterior (w/zipper teeth facing DOWN).

### Steps 25-29 (page 2)

#### Applying Zipper to Bag Top

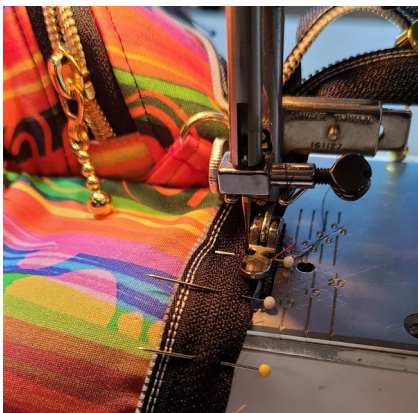
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28) Now repeat steps 26-27 to pin free zipper edge in place starting at pin marker 3/4" away from the LEFT side of Bag Front & stopping at the 3/4" pin marker closest to the RIGHT side of Bag Front. Please note how the zipper bottom area looks (*it might feel wrong but its not*).



29) Stitch a scant 1/4" from edges starting at one of the 3/4" pin markers located at the bottom zipper area...



& proceeding around Bag top area, including OVER the top zipper ends (extending over top Bag edge).



Stop stitching at the 3/4" pin marker on opposite side of zipper bottom area.



And here's how it looks now.

**Tip Box:** Once again, for easier stitching, we recommend opening the Pouch zipper completely & stuffing the Flap INSIDE the Pouch.
